RICHARD SARGENT - Richard's favorite pastimes are playing hockey and giving flowers to his many girl friends.

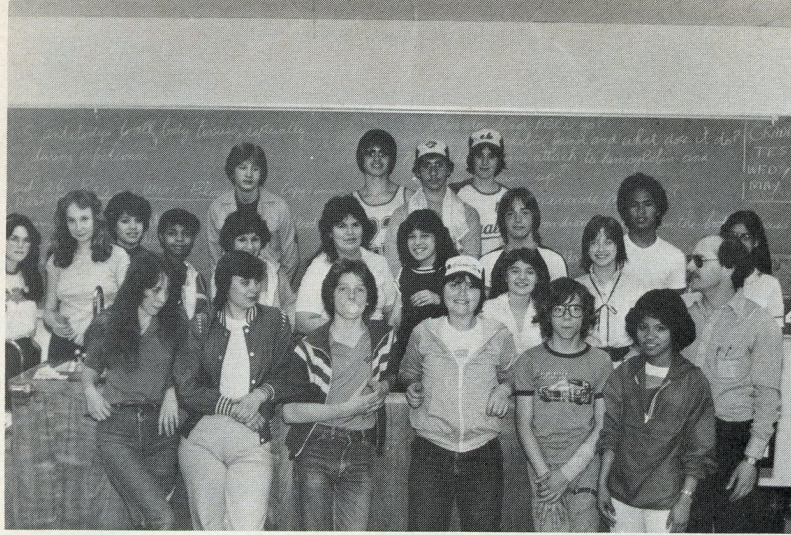
