




Throughout the year I became



The program leaders choose eight students from participating schools to take part in this program. The students are chosen after they write an essay.

On May 11th we left for Washington D.C. The first thing we did after landing was to go sightseeing. We saw the White House, the Washington Memorial, and the Vietnam Memorial. Then we went back to the hotel to get settled, explored the hotel and saw a magician. Ten O'clock was lights out and we got a 7:00 a.m. wake up call.

we learned about the Holocaust.

On the second say we went to the Holocaust Memorial Museum. The first exhibit we saw was Daniel's Story. It was based on a book we read during our

sessions. We went through the museum floor by floor looking at all the artifacts. When we got back to the hotel, we had a debriefing session where we wrote in our journals and shared our feelings with the group. After supper we went to a play called Shear Madness that is about a murder in a hair salon.



The third day we woke up, breakfast and went back to the Holocaust Memorial Museum where we went an on architectural building tour. Then we listened to a holocaust

survivor and then went to the Smithsonian museum. Then we took a chartered bus to Virginia to go to the Potomac Mall.

On the fourth and final day, we went back to the Washington Memorial and saw the plantation where George Washington used to live and where he kept his slaves.

After we returned to Winnipeg we did a fifteen-minute presentation in front of all grade 9's and on June 10th we had a graduation.

This was such a great experience for all of us and we will never forget it.
