To the undergraduates, continue to keep up the pride and glory which has made St. John's a well respected institution.


I would like to extend a very warm thank—you to the students and staff members, whose encouragement and dedication made my job a meaningful and worthwhile opportunity.

We had a "perfect" record of 0 and 15 from the three tournaments that we had participated in, but regardless, had a good time anyway.


