tried to make time for us. We were fortunate to have such committed educators and in some cases close friends.

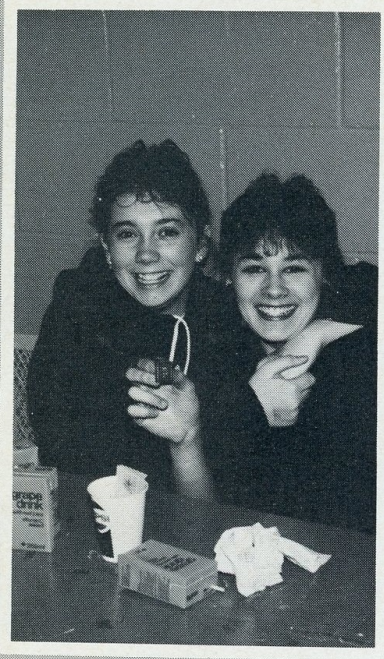

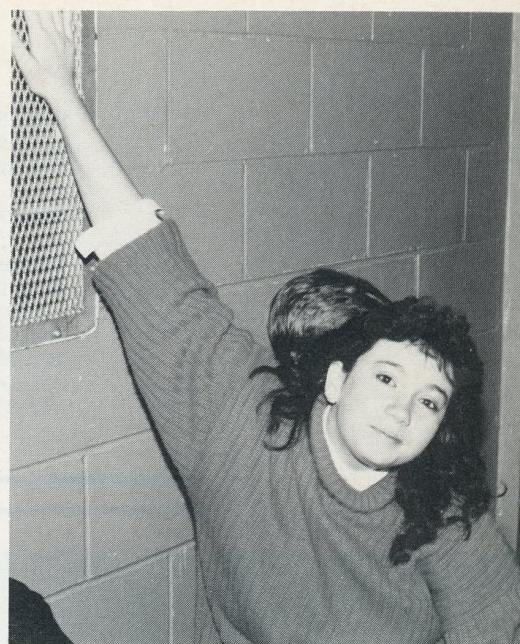
To the students returning to Jr. High next year - keep reaching for the top and never give up. Keep the spirit of St. John's alive.

Fellow graduates - let us also not forget to thank each other for the companionship we shared.

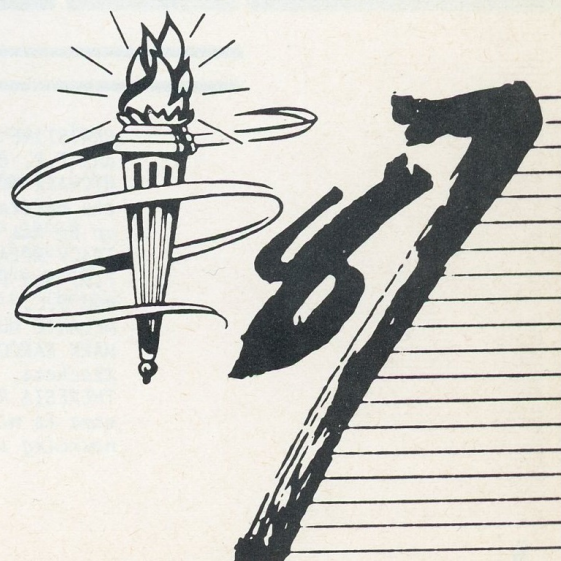
And let us use what we have learned in Jr. High to help make the world a safer, healthier, happier and a more tolerant place for all of us to live in.
