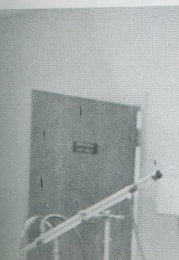
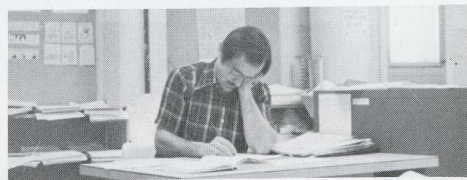
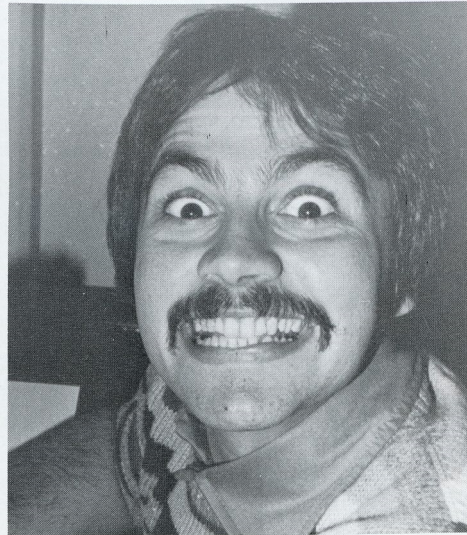
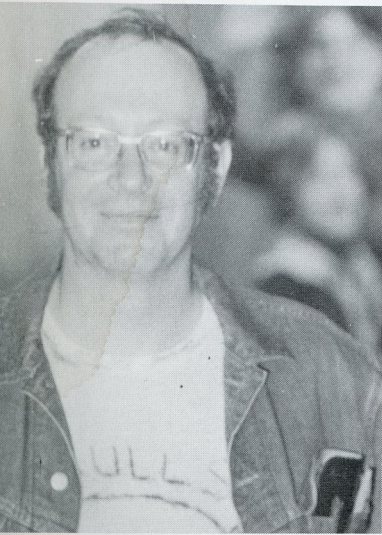
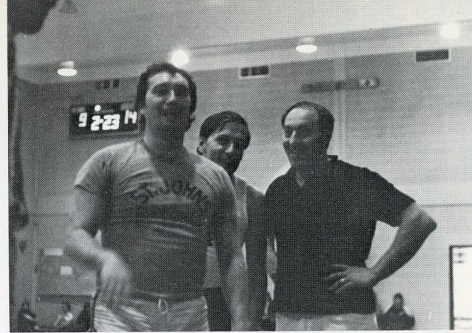
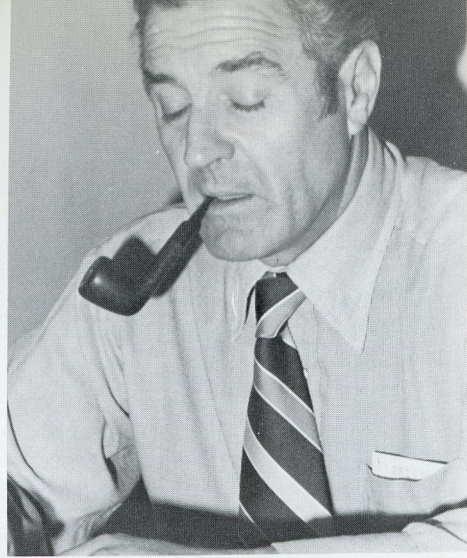
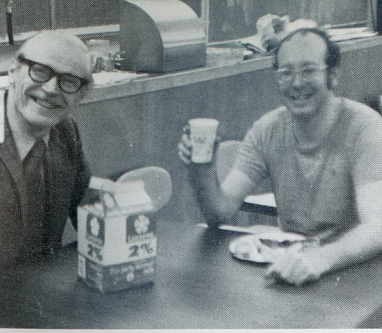
So as you see it was the best and worst of times, however the best will always be remembered.

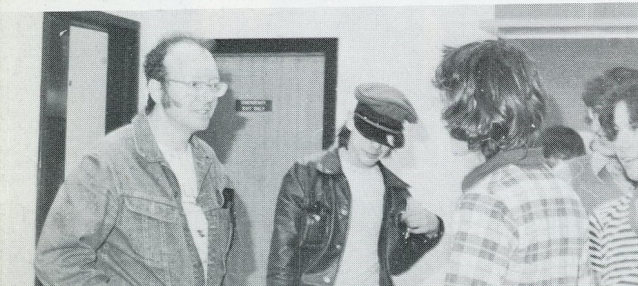
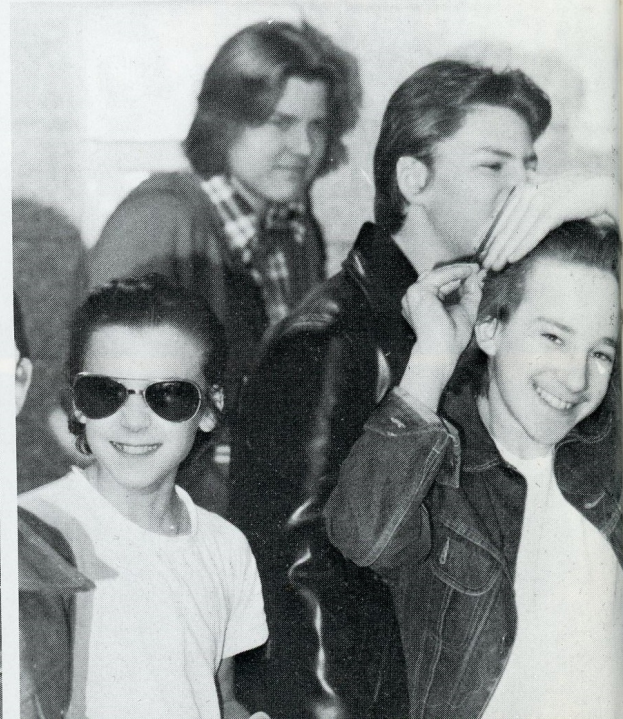
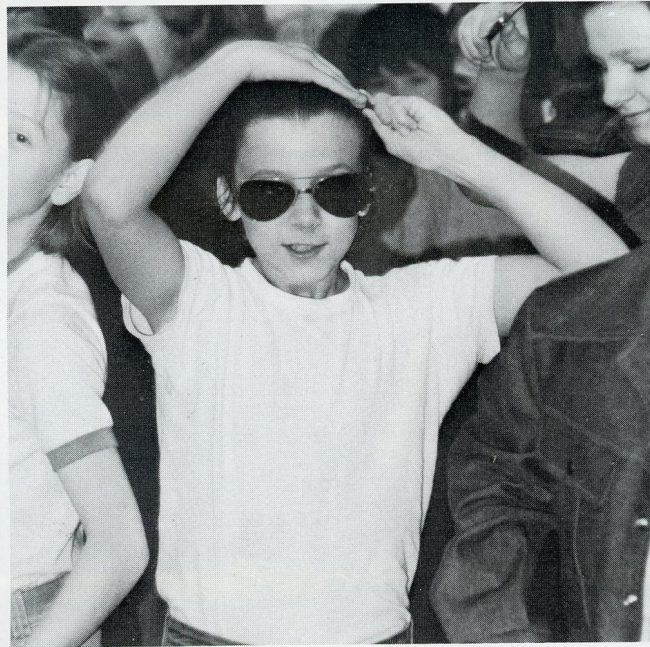




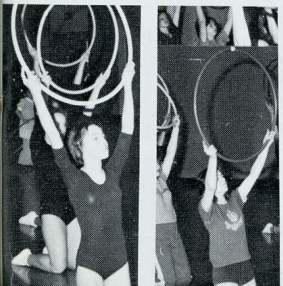
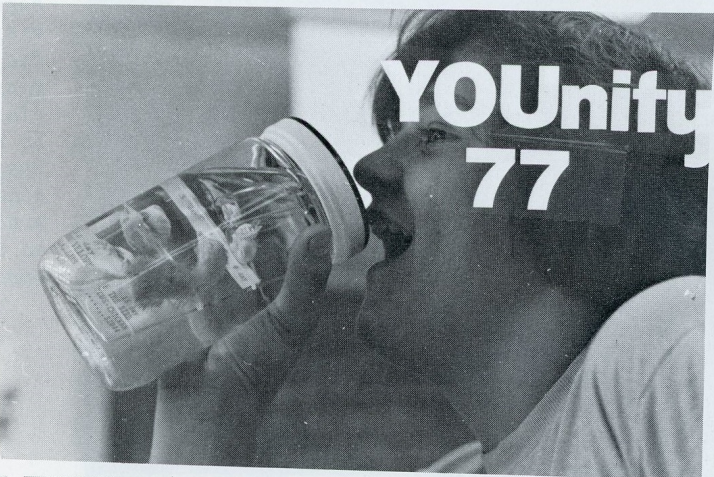
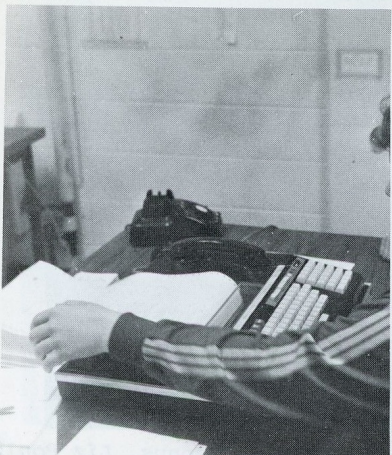


### DANCES

The orchestra performed concerts for elementary schools in May. They had four periods a cycle in which to work with Mr. Billincoff.

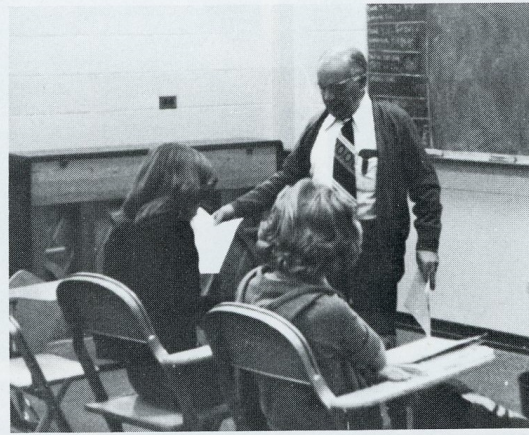
