

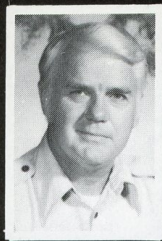
Looking back we can say that this year has given many of us pleasurable memories that we will always cherish.

In closing I would like to wish next year's Jr. High students the best of luck in carrying on the St. John's spirit.

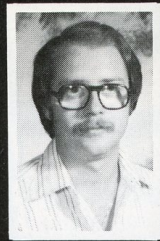
