MARCH - The school production was Brigadoon. The performance and the cast were terrific. The Jr. Sr. Girls and Boys Basketball team were chosen City Champs.

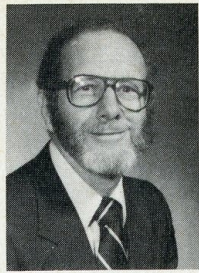
APRIL - End of spring break. Back to the books, darn.

MAY - Jr. High Field Day was at Sargeant Park this year. Great way to get in shape huh?

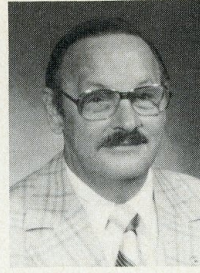

GERALD SLATER - Gerald was involved in intramural activities. Mr. T. has to strain his neck when he yells at Gerald. He converses regularly with D.F.

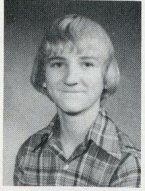
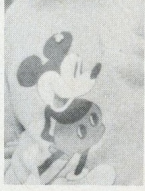
