JR. HIGH PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE.

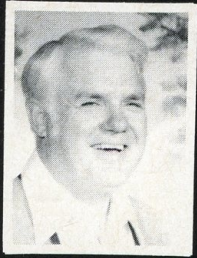

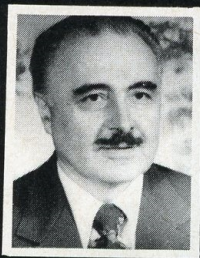
In closing I congratulate all those who have excelled in academic achievements and sport's activities.
