
The many evenings spent working and eating, and eating, and working were well worth our time.


"Anne" of Green Gables Feb. 5-8


Planning, discussing, choosing, refusing and a lot of fund raising were only a few of the grad committee's responsibilities and we really had a lot of fun doing it.
