For some this is their final year in Jr. High. They've experienced good times and bad times throughout elementary and Jr. High and now will be entering another phase in their education Senior High.

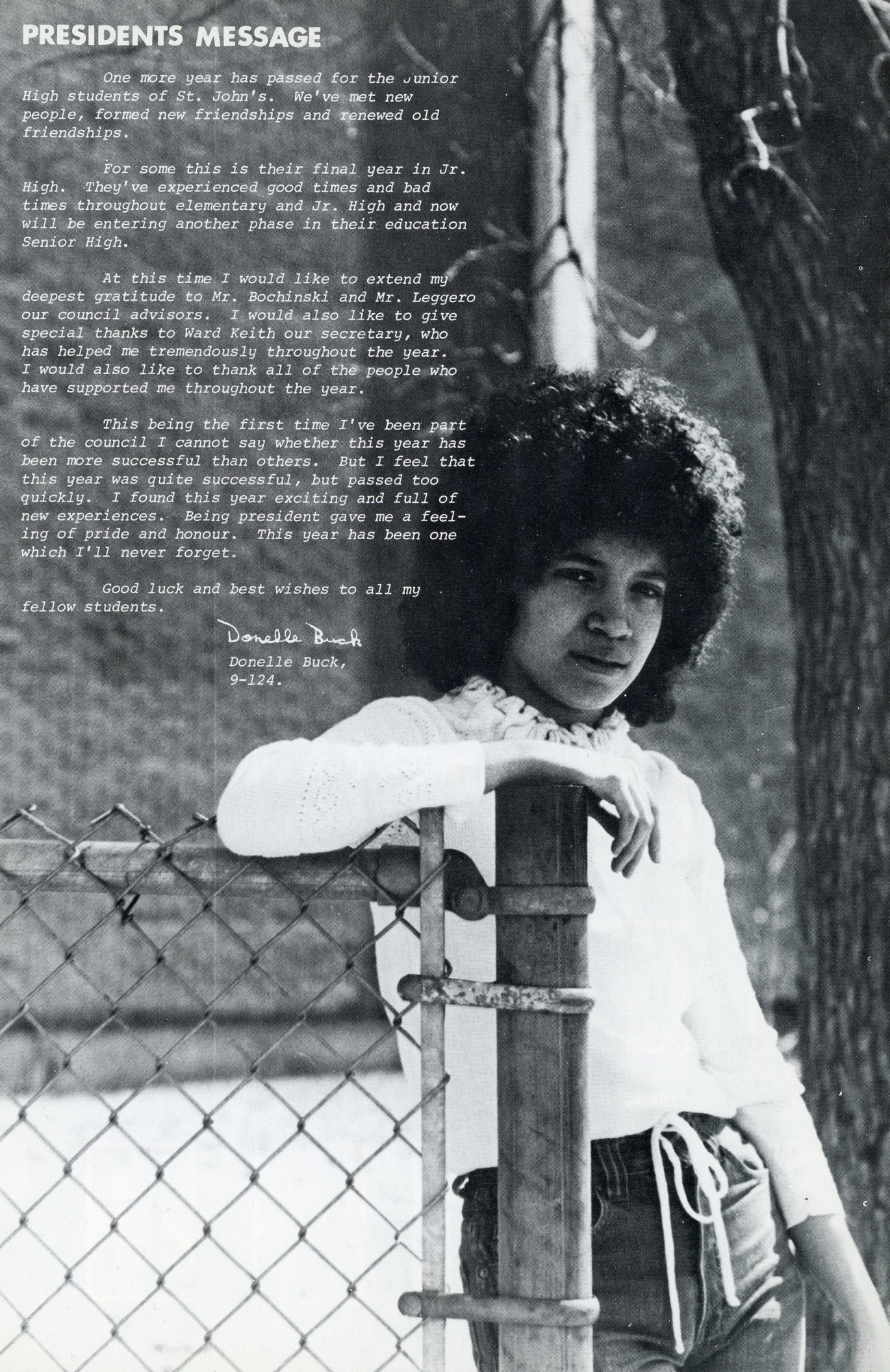

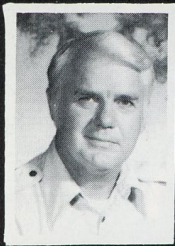

Good luck and best wishes to all my fellow students.

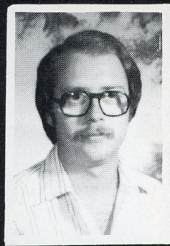
